Що таке OER?

Відкриті освітні ресурси (OER) – це матеріали для навчання, викладання та досліджень **в будь-якому форматі** й на **будь-якому носії** (цифровому або іншому), які знаходяться в суспільному надбанні або охороняються авторським правом, видані **за відкритою ліцензією**, котра дозволяє безкоштовний доступ, повторне використання, перепрофілювання, адаптацію та поширення іншими способами без обмежень.



What does an OE librarian do?

- **Asks questions, explores needs**
- **Supports finding OER**
- **Explains how to play with licences**
- **Acquires skills, adapts practices**
- **Provides guidance**
- **Co-designs policies**
- **Raises awareness through example**

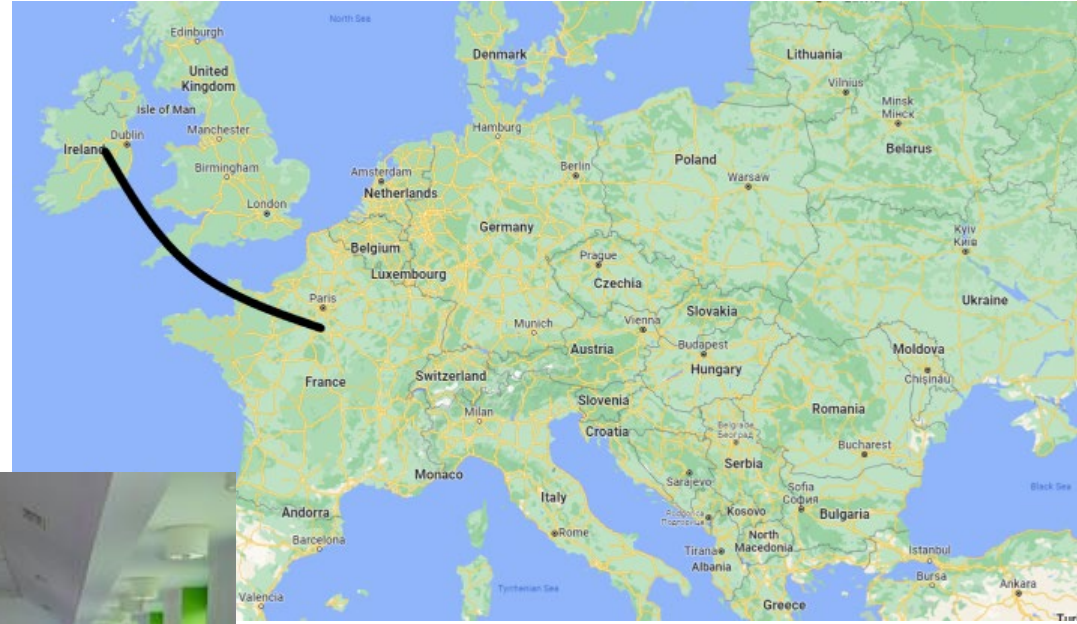
