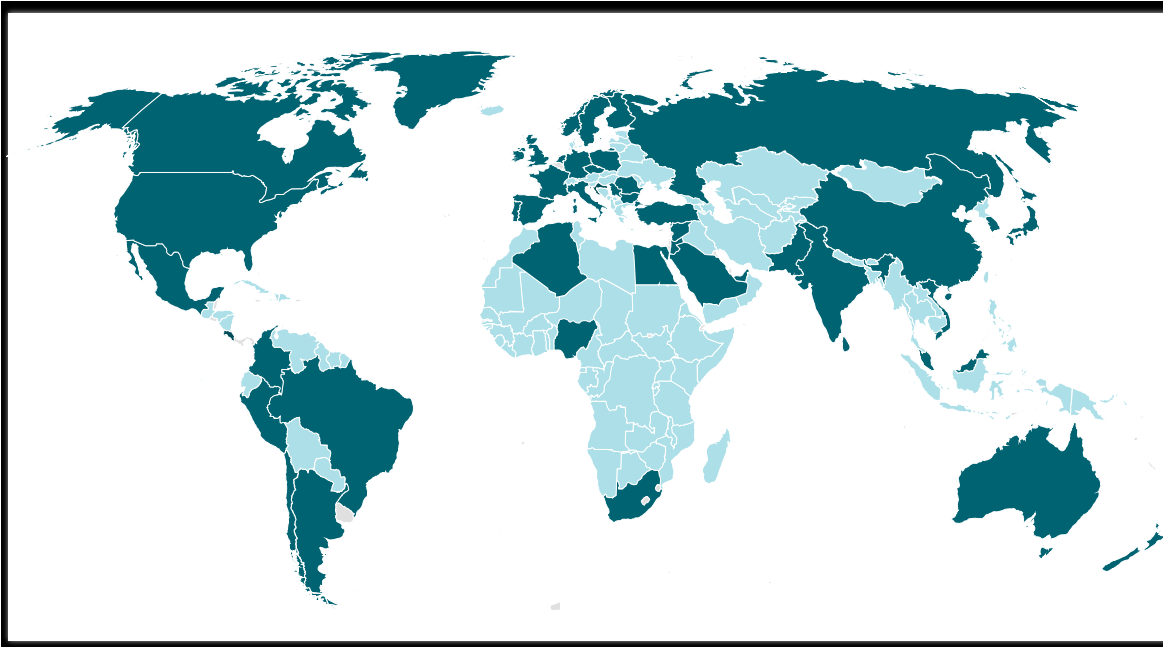

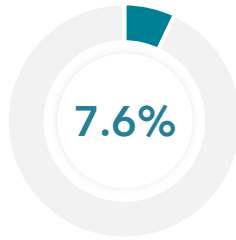

# Scholarship publication filter from dissertation to journal article



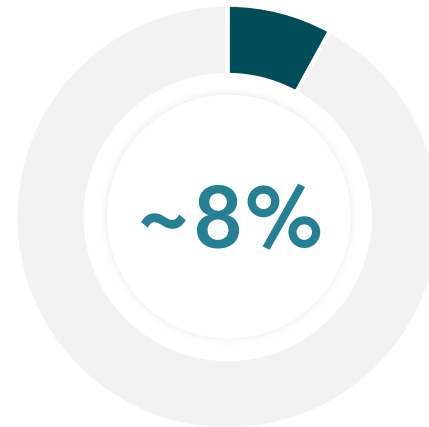

THIS DISSERTATION & THESES PROGRAM HARVESTING AGREEMENT (“Agreement”) is between ProQuest LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“ProQuest”) and its affiliates, with headquarters at 789 E. Eisenhower Parkway, P.O. Box 1346, Ann Arbor, MI 48106-1346 USA and [Institution] with headquarters located at [Address] (the “University”) as further outlined below:

- 1. → Scope of this Agreement.** Under this Agreement, the University wishes for ProQuest and ProQuest agrees to preserve, archive and distribute dissertations, abstract, and index terms provided by University’s graduate degree candidates (each an “Author”) to ProQuest (each dissertation or thesis is referred to individually as a “Work” or collectively as “the Collection”).
- 2. → Use of the Collection by ProQuest.** In consideration of ProQuest’s inclusion of the Works comprising the Collection in its Dissertations and Theses program, the University agrees that ProQuest may: (i) reproduce the full text of the Works submitted by Authors, (ii) include the full text of the Works in ProQuest’s PQDT database(s) and (iii) make microform and/or digital copies of the Works for the purposes of public reference, archiving, inter-library loan, including the sale of individual copies of Works. The University further acknowledges that ProQuest will include the abstract, bibliography and other meta-data and analysis of the Work in PQDT and any successor or related products or services. Such products may be delivered to customers in tangible and electronic formats as may be in existence now or developed in the future, whether individually or as part of electronic database or other research products and services. For the avoidance of doubt, Works may be withdrawn from distribution at the request of the author, the copyright holder or the University as provided on Exhibit A.
- 3. → Delivery and Format of the Works.** Each Work, including the dissertation, abstract, and index terms (where available) shall be made available by University and/or the Author to ProQuest through its Institutional Repository, as outlined on Exhibit A.
- 4. → Rights Verification.** The University, either directly or through its Authors, provides ProQuest with a representation that the use of the Work as contemplated by this Agreement does not infringe any rights of third parties or any contract entered into with respect to the Work. If the University or the Author discovers any reason why the Work may not be distributed as outlined in this Agreement, they may withdraw the dissertation as outlined in Exhibit A.

- 5. → Institutional Directives.** The University is solely responsible for any conflict between the policies and directions provided to ProQuest and any restriction the copyright holder may place on the use of any given Work. The University and ProQuest will work in collaboration to resolve any conflicts between the policies and direction provided by the University and any restriction the copyright holder may place on any given Work. For the avoidance of doubt, the University is solely responsible for access to the Collection that is provided through its library or institutional repository.
- 6. → Hosting and Distribution.**
  - a. →** Without charge to the University, ProQuest will host the Works and display them in response to relevant search queries from researchers. Also, without charge to the University, the University’s Authorized Users may search and retrieve the Works from ProQuest’s proprietary search and retrieval platform.
  - b. →** Authors are eligible for a royalty based upon sales of the full-text and use of their Work distributed by ProQuest, provided that the author contact [disspub@proquest.com](mailto:disspub@proquest.com) and set up an account for such purposes. If a third party claims that the use of the Works as contemplated hereunder violates the right of a third party, University and ProQuest will reasonably cooperate to address the claim in a timely manner.

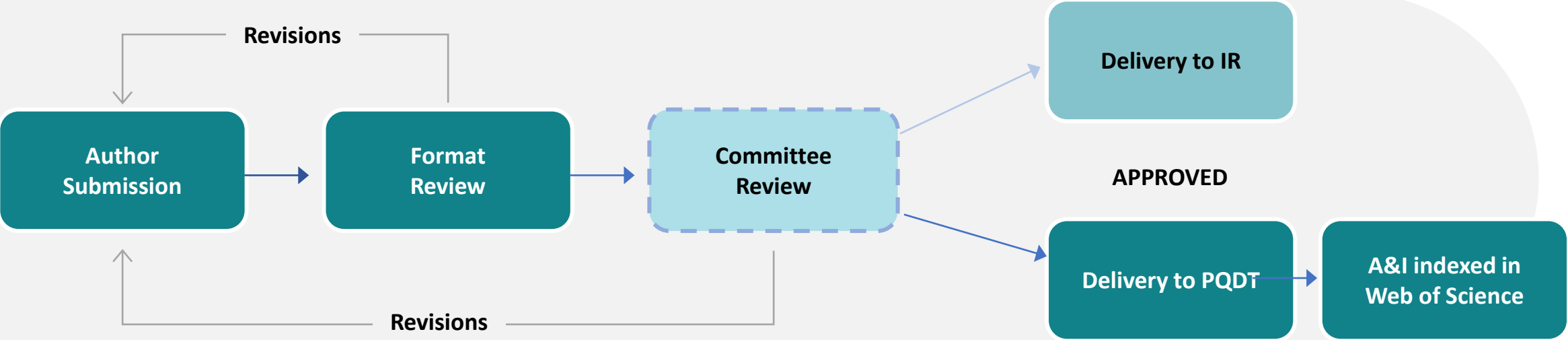

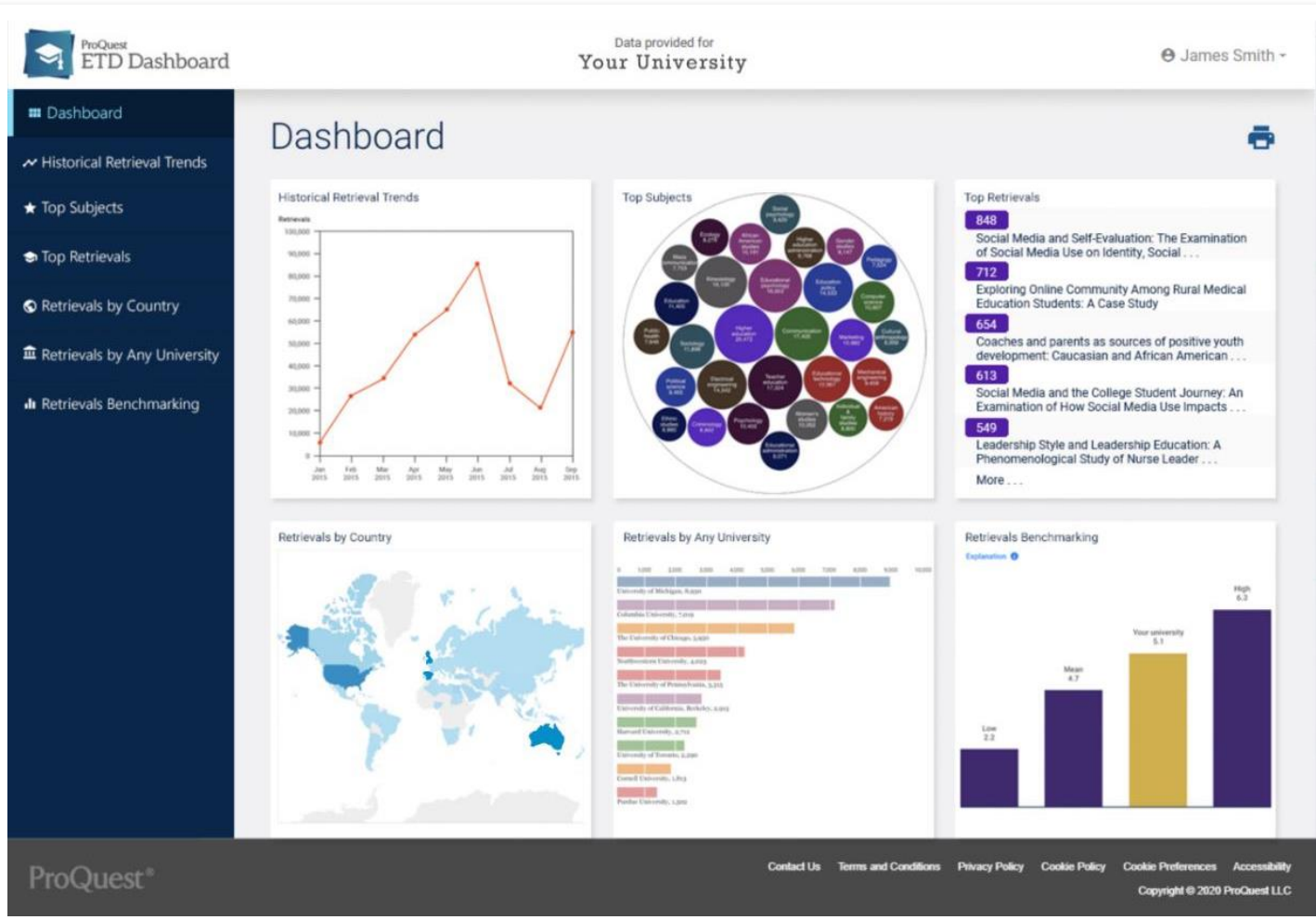

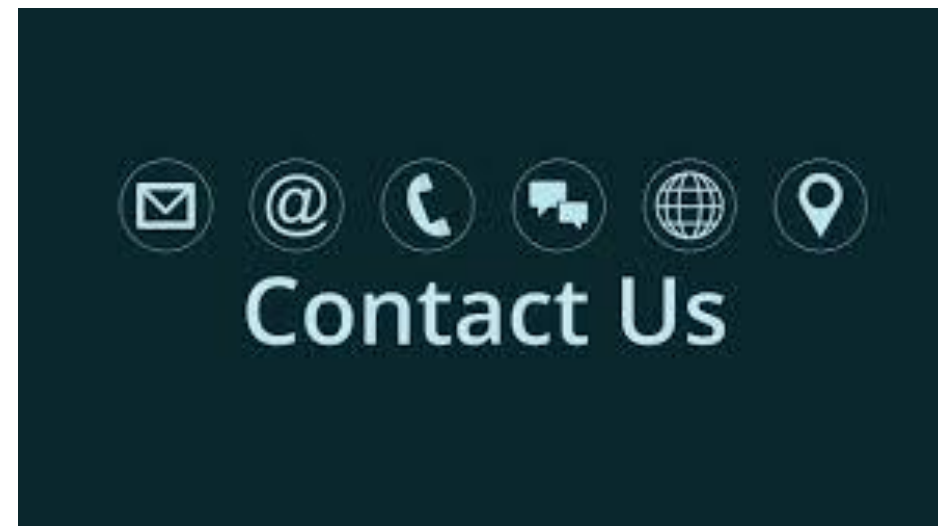
